### YEAR 7 CATCH-UP PREMIUM EXPENDITURE PLAN 2017 – 2018

#### **Introduction**

1. The year 7 catch-up premium, also referred to as the year 7 literacy and numeracy catch-up premium, provides schools with additional funding for each year 7 pupil who did not achieve the expected standard in reading and/or mathematics at the end of Key Stage (KS) 2.

#### **Eligibility**

2. For the academic year 2017-18, the school received £20529 to support those Year 7 students who were assessed as needing English and maths intervention, having secured below Level 4 in the KS2 tests.

#### **Use**

3. For the last academic year 2017-18 the money was spent on TLA Learning Mentors who specifically focused on students selected for withdrawal from certain lessons for 1-2-1 or small group support, and also supporting these students in intervention groups.

#### **Evaluation**

4. Those eligible Year 7 students eligible for this use of the catch up funding made more rapid progress than other more able categories of students:

Prior Attainment – Low	18	0.06
Prior Attainment – Middle	96	-0.23
Prior Attainment – High	47	-0.83
