We are thrilled to share some exciting news about our new community hub! Since February, we have been working really hard to prepare for our opening in September, we proudly announce that our hub will be named the

‘Burrington Community Hub’

honoring the legacy of our school, formerly known as Burrington Secondary Modern. Here are some updates on what we've accomplished so far and our plans for the coming months:

Accomplishments to Date:

- **Steering Committee:** various community members dedicated to guiding and supporting our initiatives.
- **Community Engagement:** We have hosted coffee mornings to gather insights on what the community desires from our space. Also based on feedback, we have adjusted our Classcharts points system and revamped our rewards program to recognize and celebrate consistently high-achieving students.
- **Partnership with Honicknowle Youth Centre:** Utilising our space during their exciting refurbishment, this collaboration brings a youth worker on-site and allows the Plymouth-wide Young Carers Program to run
- **Resource Mapping:** We can offer well-informed advice and support to anyone unsure of where to seek assistance available, regarding local services and assets
- **Collaboration with Stakeholders:** We have built strong relationships with key stakeholders like the YMCA to maximise the use of our facilities for the community's benefit.
- **A38 Bridge:** We have engaged in discussions with National Highways and Plymouth City Council about the height of the parapets on the bridge outside our school and expressed our concern, discussions are ongoing.
- **New Outdoor Facilities:** Funded two new outdoor table tennis tables, available to the community from September.
- **Traffic Safety:** Our listening campaign survey highlighted concerns about speeding outside our school. We are pleased to announce the installation of brand-new speed cameras, ensuring safety for everyone in our community.
