1st August Parent Order Deadline

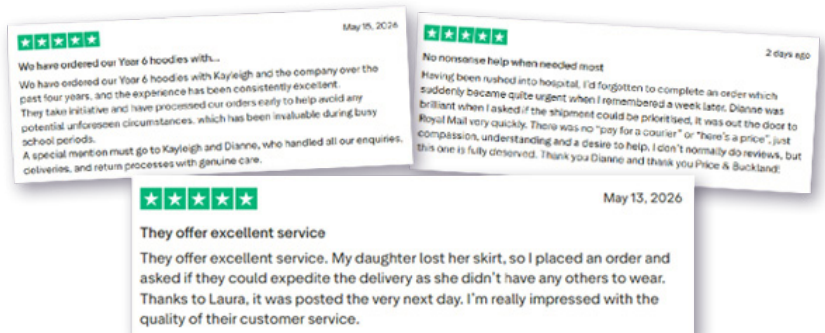
As in previous years, if your parents use our online service, we would appreciate your support in promoting the 1st August order deadline.

Children's Wellbeing & Schools Act Now in Force

With the Children's Wellbeing & Schools Act now officially in force, we have seen many schools reviewing and adapting their uniform policies to align with the new regulations.

Many schools have reduced the number of compulsory branded items, helping to keep costs down for families.

Optional branded items such as hats, bags, coats, and sports overgarments can still be offered, provided that an equivalent unbranded alternative is also permitted.

It is also worth noting that items such as tartan skirts or embroidered skirts are not considered compulsory so long as pupils have the option of wearing plain garments instead.
